PRACTICING ON THE GREENS

When coming to the Club for practice, please **check the whiteboard** on the side of the entrance of the clubhouse to see which greens are available for practice and the direction to play.

When practicing members please make use of all rinks, not just the ones closest to the clubrooms and when practicing on the artificial, you change the direction of play occasionally.

GREEN REPORT

Patrick has worked diligently on the Greens, and to his credit we have A Green performing better than expected since opening late November, for a newly established surface.

The priority with B Green is to maintain healthy turf cover and play the green at whatever speed the surface naturally provides.

It is planned to commence major work on this early April 2026.

Sweeping and blowing continues regularly on C Green to reduce debris and reduce mould and contamination risk.

C Green has remained in use longer than anticipated, to protect A green from over-use while still maturing, and while B green held excess moisture, to protect both from excessive damage.
